

30. Learning about Systems Thinking and Thinking Systemically about Learning - Janis Dutton, Author, Schools that Learn (A Fifth Discipline Fieldbook)

Our session will engage participants in exploring the web of learning—the multiple connections required for learning, and the structural dynamics of those connections, beyond the boundaries of the field of knowledge being studied. These dynamic tensions are at play with all learners—child and adult. Participants will help create a framework to reflect critically on their practices in multiple learning environments—the classroom, with colleagues, and in their own learning—to recognize and make these connections. the introductory lessons and activities teachers and students have done as follow-up within their own curriculum.
